<p>Goldilocks and the Three Bears</p>	<p>Outdoors – Mud kitchen area</p> <p>Resources</p> <p>1 broken chair and 2 normal chairs of different sizes</p> <p>1 table</p> <p>3 bowls of different sizes</p> <p>3 spoons of different sizes</p> <p>Mud / water / pans for cooking porridge</p> <p>Role play story using real props</p> <p>How did the chair break?</p> <p>Can we fix it?</p> <p>Who would fix it?</p> <p>How can we fix it?</p> <p>Which chair belongs to Daddy Bear and why do you think this?</p> <p>Same questions with bowls and spoons etc</p> <p>What would happen if Daddy Bear used this chair / this spoon?</p> <p>Explore questions from weekly activities....</p>
<p>Jack and the Beanstalk</p>	<p>Outdoors</p> <p>Resources</p> <p>Planting equipment</p> <p>Beans</p> <p>Ladders</p> <p>Tape measures</p>

	<p>Rulers</p> <p>Loose parts</p> <p>Builders tray</p> <p>Plant beans in plant pots. Whilst doing this have the discussions:</p> <p>What do you think will happen to the bean?</p> <p>Will it stay a bean, or will it change now it is in the soil?</p> <p>What did Jack do with the bean and what happened to the bean?</p> <p>Do you think our beans will grow?</p> <p>Explore questions from weekly activities....</p>
<p>Billy Goats Gruff</p>	<p>Large blocks</p> <p>Loose parts</p> <p>Selection of large pieces of material</p> <p>Large chalks</p> <p>Material</p> <p>Roleplay the story</p> <p>Create a bridge. How can they do this? How big does it need to be? Who is going to trip trap over it?</p> <p>How does it feel to be the troll?</p> <p>How does it feel to be the billy goats?</p> <p>Explore questions from weekly activities....</p>

<p>Little Red Riding Hood</p>	<p>Den building equipment</p> <p>Loose parts</p> <p>Mud kitchen</p> <p>Basket</p> <p>Red cape</p> <p>Old glasses</p> <p>Can you make a picnic basket for Red Riding Hood?</p> <p>What do you think she would like in her basket?</p> <p>What do you think granny would like?</p> <p>Explore questions from weekly activities....</p>
<p>The Elves and the Shoemaker</p>	<p>Den building</p> <p>Selection of shoes / boots / trainers..... of different sizes</p> <p>Loose parts</p> <p>Selection of off cuts of materials</p> <p>Tools</p> <p>Which shoes do you like?</p> <p>Which shoes would you wear for.....</p> <p>How can we make shoes? What can we use?</p> <p>Explore questions from weekly activities....</p>
<p>The Little Red Hen</p>	<p>Mud Kitchen</p> <p>Wheat</p> <p>Recipe for bread</p> <p>Inside – opportunity to make bread and ask questions around ingredients and <i>What if we didn't put something in to make the bread, what would happen?</i></p>



<p>Gingerbread Man</p>	<p>Cooking opportunity inside</p> <p>Baking equipment</p> <p>Gingerbread ingredients</p> <p>Instructions to make gingerbread.</p> <p>Children weigh and mix ingredients.</p> <p>Opportunities to discuss the changes in properties.</p> <p>What would happen if you did not put in the mix?</p> <p>How do we make the shape of a gingerbread man?</p> <p>Do you think he will come to life?</p> <p>Explore questions from weekly activities....</p>
